Introduction

Policy Statement

Political Contributions

The Company does not make political contributions or engage in political activities that may compromise its integrity or breach anti-corruption laws.

Reporting and Compliance

Reporting Suspected Violations

Employees, agents, contractors, and business partners must promptly report any suspected violations of this policy or any corrupt activities they become aware of. If preferred, reports can be made to the designated personnel/through an anonymous reporting mechanism.

Non-Retaliation

The Company prohibits retaliation against individuals who make good-faith reports of suspected violations. Retaliation is a serious violation of our policy and will result in disciplinary action, including termination of employment or contract.

Compliance Training

The Company is committed to providing regular anti-corruption training and awareness programs to its employees and relevant business partners to ensure a clear understanding of the policy and its implications.


